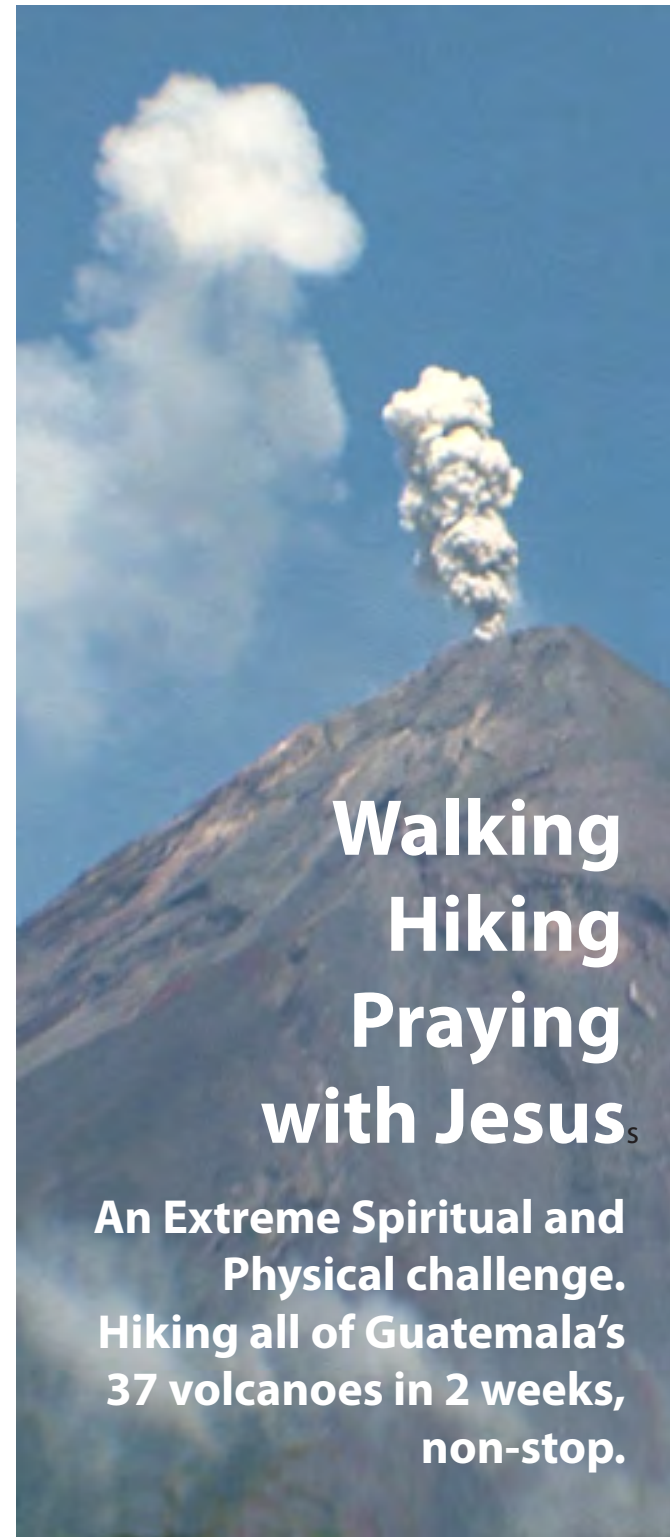

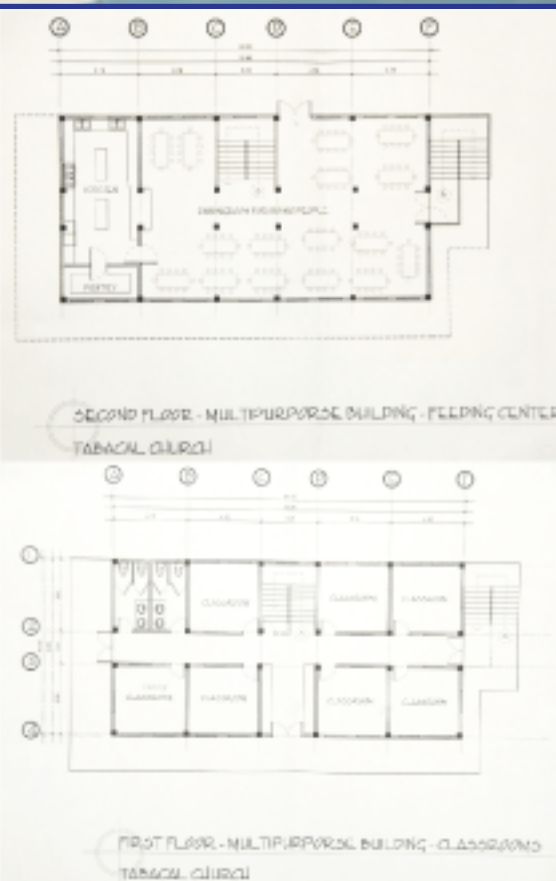


**Walking

**HOW:** We have devoted 1 year for physical, mental and Spiritual preparation. We need to raise a prayer team to begin to pray for us, and to pray everyday during the Walking, Hiking and Praying with Jesus event.

**Our Vision** is to build a New Bible Teaching and Training Center with a feeding program that will help to disciple and educate the children and young people at the Mayan community of Tabacal. This is a community of about 50 families that live in poverty. The new building will be a two stories; the first floor will have a 7 classrooms, and the second floor will have a kitchen and dining room for about 170 people. This building can be used to develop the Tabacal Church programs and can be used as a multipurpose building by the Mayan Community at Tabacal



Charlie and I see this as opportunity to do something together as father and son. At the same time we will raise prayer and financial support from all over the United States to help us accomplish a dream

**WHEN:** During the month of November is the best time climb in Guatemala, it is not the raining season and the views are spectacular. It will be a little cold, but good for hiking.

**Our Financial Goal** is \$37,000, or \$1000 for each Volcano; to do this we are praying for financial support teams. We want to invite churches, ministries, buisnesses, individuals and families to be a part of this adventure. For example I want to ask each person to adopt 1 volcano for \$1,00.00 and find another 9 people for their team who can do the same. In this way a team can adopt 1 volcano for \$1,000.00.
